The Rosslare Affair

Environment and Topography

- Relatively flat peninsula, 200-500yrds wide, 8 greens 30yrds from beach or dune
- Dynamic dune system (no indigenous sand quarry)
- Sand based spit
- 130 acres site
- 2 hectares of greens
- Fully automated irrigation system
- Annual rainfall 800-1000mm
- 30 golf buggies
- 30,000 rounds per annum



The Good The Bad and the Ugly.

How did it get this way?

- Verti-cutting/scarifying
- Irrigation, limited system, not measured accurately, not tested for quality,
- Mowing at 3-4mm with triplex
- Hollow-coring.
- Application of 255kg/ha N per year. (Uriec Nitrogen)
- Sporadic use of wetting agents (Fairy washing up liquid as surfactant)
- Preventative spraying for fusarium and anthracnose. (15 applications in 2005)
- Minimal dew removal when greens not mown
